

GOOD HOPE FILMS TRAINEE PROGRAM, Dec. 12-20, 2016

Good Hope Films, LLC, a Houston-based production company, is offering a crew training program during its upcoming production. The project, *Bagatelle*, will be shot on Super 16mm Kodak film over the course of five days in December in Cuero, TX. Trainees will have the opportunity to learn the skills and craftsmanship required by a celluloid-based film project. The cost of program attendance is \$600 per 12-hour shift. School credit is available. Trainees are responsible for their own room and board, ground transportation to Cuero and throughout project.

Trainees will observe the work of Ziv Berkovich ([Another World](#), [Self Made](#)), a leading Israeli cinematographer whose films screened at the Cannes Film Festival as part of the Cinéfondation and Semaine de la Critique, and at the Rotterdam, Locarno, and Jerusalem international film festivals. Ziv studied under the legendary Russian director of photography Vadim Yusov (Andrey Tarkovsky's [Solaris](#), [Andrey Rublev](#), [Ivan's Childhood](#)).
